First Friday Together

This is an opportunity for people with dementia and those who support or care for them to meet, share experiences and gain information. There is time for those with dementia and their carers/supporters to meet in separate groups. Cost: 50p donation for refreshments.

*** For those caring for someone in residential care**

Each month our First Friday meeting starts at 0930 for carers of people who have moved into residential care, offering support for their specific needs. The regular meeting for carers and those they care for starts at 1030.

Drop-in Information & Advice Session:

Do you need help in applying for Attendance Allowance, Carer's Allowance, Blue Badge application and/or help and advice with legal power of attorney. Come and join us between 1700-1830hrs prior to our Thursday Together session.

Thursday Together

A social evening for people with dementia and those who support and care for them to enjoy together. All the family are welcome. Thursday Together runs on the second Thursday of the month from 1830-2030hrs. Cost: £1 donation for refreshments.

Music Sessions

This is an opportunity to enjoy singing together in a happy atmosphere. These music sessions are for people with dementia and those who support and care for them. Sessions run on the 2nd and 4th Friday of the month. Costs: 50p donation for refreshments.

Understanding Dementia

In these sessions, we consider what physical changes may be behind the experience of dementia; how people may be feeling and how their thinking, memory and relationships may be affected. How can we support them through communicating with them and understanding their needs and sense of reality?

This session is ideal for anyone who is interested in learning more about dementia, especially family carers, staff working in care homes and home care, as well as for people volunteering or working in the community. It is open to anyone. Cost: £5 per person.

Bereaved Support Group

A group has come together of people who have been bereaved following caring for a person close to them who had dementia. Meeting for coffee/tea and sometimes for lunch as well provides support and an opportunity to share experiences but also for companionship. Cost: 50p donation for refreshments.

Rugby Forget-me-not Friends

In partnership with Age UK Coventry and Warwickshire we run a small befriending scheme for people with dementia and their carers who are isolated and therefore unable to come to our RDS meetings. If you know of anyone, or a couple, living with dementia who are isolated and would appreciate a weekly visit from a volunteer, please contact Jane. We are also looking for new volunteers.

Cognitive Stimulation
